Q&A

The Theater

- Where (location) is the dance recital show?

Coral Springs Arts Center, 2855 Coral Springs Dr, Coral Springs, FL 33065

- When will the doors open at the dance recital?

30 mins prior to show.

- Will my child be checked in and out at the day of dress rehearsal and Recital day performance?

Yes. This is called the Dismissal Process in which during Dress Rehearsal-students will be dismissed after all of their numbers have been rehearsed (upon teacher approval). Day of Recital students will be dismissed at the END of the show.

- Where is my dancer's dressing room?

All students will be assigned a dressing room.

- Will there be separate dressing room for the boys?

Yes. There is a separated area backstage sectioned off for the boys.

- Are we allowed to videotape and will we be allowed to take photographs of our dancer's performances? There will be no cameras permitted at the recital! Please pre-purchase your recital video online with your tickets or at the studio.

- Will there be snacks and water sold at the dance recital during intermission?

Yes, there is a concession stand.

- How many times will I see my dancer on the stage?

Every performer is required to do FINALE. Each dancer is on stage for however many performances they are part of plus the finale.

- Can I see my child during intermission or at any other time during the show?

No. Due to the schedule and functionality of the show, seeing your child during the show risks delaying the entire production therefore they will not be permitted to come out of the dressing room until it is time for dismissal.

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- Once my dancer is done performing will she be able to sit down with her family to watch in the audience?

No. Your child will not be dismissed until after the finale they have been rehearsing to perform for you in addition to their class choreography. You are welcome to get seat for them if you are watching another show then they may sit with you then.

- What happens if my dancer decides she does not want to dance once she is on the stage?
The dance continues regardless.

- How do you assign the classes to each show?
This year "Tales of Oz" will tell the story of Oz in Dancer's Gallery Style!!!

- Who cares for my child backstage and what can they bring if they get hungry?
Stage Moms/DG Staff & yes, they may bring clean snacks that don't have sauces or can get on their costumes. Nothing greasy or with sauces please. Bring in a disposable snack bag.

- Where do I pick up my child after they are done dancing?
Pick up is in front of the Green Room (outside).

- Can I send another parent to pick up my child?
Yes. We will only release your child to the person (s) listed on the Dismissal form

- How long will each show last and how long is intermission?
The 10am Baby Show will be about an hour. The other two shows will be approximately 2 ½ to 3 hours. There will be three shows 10:00am for children 4 and younger, a 1:00pm & 6:00pm show.

TICKETS

- How does seating work at the theater?
Seating charts will be viewable when you purchase tickets online so that you can choose your seats. Be advised that there are no middle rows in the main floor seating chart. The lines seen in the seating chart are to show the curving of the seat rows.

- At what age do you require to purchase a ticket to watch show?
When they can no longer watch the show on your lap. We do not want to disturb the families behind you.

- Does my dancer need to purchase a ticket too and is there a recital fee?
There is no recital fee for performers. They do not need a ticket unless they are watching another show they are not performing in.

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- Are tickets available for wheelchair seating?

Yes. Seating is located by the back of the main floor in the auditorium and throughout the theater, see seating charts.

- How much are tickets, when will I be able to order them and how many can I order?

Tickets prices are \$20, \$25 \$30, \$35 and \$42 plus online ticket company fee depending on seating.

- Do you limit the number of tickets each family can buy and is there assigned seating?

There is no limit & you can purchase seating upon availability.

- How do I retrieve my tickets?

Beginning May 1st, purchased tickets will be released and able to be printed at home. Printing them is the fastest way into the theater on recital day but may also be retrieved via mobile device at the door.

- Can you buy tickets at the door?

In light of some families being uncertain if guests can make it to the show & therefore don't buy them a ticket, there are tickets available at the door for \$45 the day of recital.

- What if tickets sell out before I get my mine?!

Tickets don't typically sell out due to multiple shows. The theater is large with 2 levels ample seating. The best seats in the house do sell quickly, so grab your seats as soon as you are able.

- If I do not use a ticket can, I receive a refund?

All ticket purchases are a final sale and there are no refunds given.

Procedures

- Is dress rehearsal mandatory?

Yes. All dancers are required to be at dress rehearsal in order to participate in recital. No exceptions

- When is the deadline to submit Ads/messages in the recital booklet for my dancer?

May 6th, 2019 & submit complete Ad materials by May 15th. All ad requests must be done online at www.recital-ads.com no matter how you paid for your ad and even if it was part of a package. Your ad creation is taken from this submission. Please make sure to follow this step to not miss being in the program.

- When & how will I be able to order a dance recital video of my dancer's show?

Orders can be placed online while you are ordering your tickets, just add to your cart. This is the best way.

- Where do we pick up our flower orders or our cake orders? Where will I pick up our recital shirts?

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There will be Dancer's Gallery tables set up inside the lobby as soon as you walk in with flowers/cakes. The recital shirts will be distributed back stage from the stage moms within their groups.

- What do stage moms do?

They are assigned to a group of students. They must attend to all the children they are assigned to. All hair, makeup, and costume must be well put together. They escort their groups from the green room to the stage and back to keep them safe.

- Do I get a refund or a credit if for any reason my dancer cannot make it to the recital?

NO. All Sales are Final.

- Will my child be able to participate in the recital if my balance is not completely paid?

No. All balances must be satisfied prior to the show. If you have a balance and a family member purchases a ticket online please know that we will not release tickets for that performer unless account is in good standing.

Be Prepared

- How do I make my dancer's tutu look nice?

Hang it upside down and steam it. If you have a platter tutu you may place it underneath your bed.

- What color tights does my dancer wear?

Depends on the costume. The tag on their costume will indicate what color they need.

- What should my dancer's hair look like?

Part on dancer's left side with a low secured bun. Unless told otherwise by instructor.

- Do the dancers wear underwear under their costumes?

No. Nude garment can be used if necessary.

- Should my dancer wear make up for the dress rehearsal and for the recital?

Yes! Full make-up for both shows.

- What kind of jewelry is allowed on my dancer? Will there be nail polish allowed?

No jewelry is allowed including stud earrings! No nail polishes!

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Additional Notes

- Please be sure that your dancer's costumes are unwrinkled by either steaming them with a steamer or by turning on a hot shower and hanging your dancer's costumes in the hot bathroom to get them unwrinkled.
- Please write your dancer's name or at least initials in his/her dance shoes and all of their belongings, so that if anything gets misplaced, we can get them back to you.
- If there are any tags inside your dancer's outfit that are visible when your dancer puts it on, please cut them out.
- If you have a hair accessory, please be sure to use bobby pins to secure it in place, so that it does not fall off onstage. Hair accessories always go on dancer's right side.
- If packing a bag of snacks, ONLY pack food & drinks that won't stain such as dry snacks and water.

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
