

Dear Parent/Student:

We are so excited that your child will be joining us for our Performing Arts Summer Camp 2020! Our camp hours are Monday – Friday, 9am – 4 pm. Extended care is offered 7:30am – 6pm at no additional charge.

The first session begins Monday, June 8th and there is no camp July 4th. Our performances will be recorded and sent to each performer rather than offer live shows this year. We feel this will lessen any additional risk to the children and staff.

Premade lunch will be provided. Snacks can be brought from home or parents have the option of adding funds into a designated snack account. Please see Ms. Ana in the cafeteria to set up their accounts. Two snack breaks will be given each day. Please also send water with each dancer as the water fountain is for emergencies only.

Students are required to be in the appropriate uniform every day. Campers will also be provided one free camp shirt. Additional shirts can be purchased at \$20 each.

Dancers should wear:

- camp shirt every day
- black leotard or 2 piece dance outfit
- black leggings or dance shorts
- tan jazz shoes
- sneakers

No cubby will be provided. Each dancer will need a dance bag to keep their items and bring home with them each day.

Summer Camp Program Policies

Parents, please review the following procedures with your children.

Guidance

Our goal is to establish and maintain a behavior management system which will reinforce the following positive behaviors:

- Respect Others
- Respect Property
- Stay with your Group
- Leave Personal Belongings at Home

If my child's behavior seriously violates the safety of any child or staff, I understand that he/she may be temporarily excluded from the program. In these circumstances, I agree that a parent or authorized adult will pick up my child within 30 minutes of notification.

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Discipline

1. Should inappropriate behavior occur, the concern will be discussed with the students, and a written warning will be given.
2. Should inappropriate behavior continue, a second warning will be given and the parents will be notified.
3. Continued behavior problems may result in permanent dismissal. (Refunds will not be given.)

Parents may set up a meeting with the program coordinator to discuss individual needs and concerns. We use a consistent, positive approach including redirection, diversion and separation, always promoting self-discipline. Parents will be notified if there is a consistent behavior problem.

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Illness

It is in the best interest of your child and the other children if you keep your child at home when he or she is ill. Children with fever, diarrhea, or vomiting will not be admitted to the program. If a child becomes ill while at the program, the parent will be called immediately to pick up the child. Parents will be notified regarding contagious illnesses.

Children will be readmitted when they are no longer contagious. No child will be permitted to participate in silks classes with rashes, uncovered sores, etc. (contagious or not) do to the nature of the activity.

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Medication

In accordance with state law, we will not dispense any medication to any child.

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Child Pick-Up and Drop-Off

Parents will give the program the names of all persons authorized to pick up their children. Staff will ask for picture ID of anyone they do not know. Persons not listed as authorized to pick up will not be allowed to check out a child.

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Uniform

All students are required to wear the proper Dancer's Gallery uniform and shoes. Please refer to the welcome letter for the uniform schedule or ask staff if unsure.

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Personal Belongings

We are not responsible for lost or missing items. Please leave all unnecessary items at home.

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Lunch/Snacks

Lunch will be provided. Two snack breaks are given each day. Parents have the option of adding funds into a designated snack account or packing snacks from home. Please see Ms. Ana in the cafeteria to set up accounts.
